- 2. Apply here for the RSAngels' 2022 Ascend Summit Grant, including all required supporting material, by March 4, 2022,
- 3. Be registered with IRSF for the Ascend Summit by March 4, 2022, and,
- 4. Not be a member of the RSAngels' Board of Directors.

- 1. A limited number of Grants will be approved on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- 2. The maximum amount of the Grant per family is \$750.
- The Grant will be provided as a reimbursement of allowed expenses within 30 days of submittal of attendee's receipts and supporting documentation
- The Grant may be applied to parent/guardian 4.

 - train-fare, airfare, bus-fare or government-per-diem mileage expenses to and from New York/ New England and Nashville between April 26 – May 1, 2022, and,
